

INSTRUCTION

on the preparation and conduct of the test in medical genetics for 3rd year students of the specialty GENERAL MEDICINE

1. In accordance with clause 1.4. "Order No193 general. On May 12, 2020, the Department of Medical Biology with a course of microbiology and virology conducts intermediate certification in medical genetics remotely in writing in the form of test tasks drawn up in Google forms.

2. The tests are compiled on the basis of QUESTIONS TO PREPARE FOR THE TEST, which are posted on the website of the department and were given to each student at the beginning of the study of the discipline. Lecture material and basic textbooks of disciplines were used to compile the tests (see the list of exam questions).

3. The test is performed by students who have completed the discipline program. Admission to the test is carried out until December 30, 2025 inclusive. Students are given the opportunity to retake it once during the credit week. Students who do not pass the test within the specified time frame remain for retake in the next semester.

4. **In advance (at least a day) before the exam or test in a distance format, the student must create a google account.**

5. The test task for credit consists of 50 test questions and three situational tasks: determination of clinical phenotype. In each task, you are offered to choose one correct answer out of five possible, from which you must choose the correct ones.

6. 1 minute is allotted to complete one task, plus 1.5 minutes to solve a situational task (Example: 50 tasks × for 1 minute = 50 minutes + 4.5 minutes for solving the problem and 1.5 minutes for the registration of personal data. After the time specified in the instructions, online access to the test will be closed.

7. The test will be carried out strictly in accordance with the approved schedule. Students answer the questions of the test task strictly on their day according to the schedule. Time allotted for completing tasks 56 min.

8. The heads of the subgroups must provide the teacher with the email addresses of all students in their group on the eve of the scheduled test.

9. On the day of the test, the student will receive a link to a Google form by e-mail, which will open for this student at the appointed time and will be closed after 56 minutes.

10. When doing the work, mark the correct answer by placing the cursor on it and pressing the left mouse button – a black dot will appear in the left field. Read the question carefully. There is only one correct answer to each question.

11. When you finish replying, click "Submit" – without this, your result will not be available for analysis.

12. Your email addresses and IP addresses are recorded by the system, so you will not be able to re-enter the test after clicking "Submit".

13. Credit evaluation criteria: Credit is given to the student who completes the discipline program and scores 40% or more of the correct answers. If less than 40% of correct answers are collected, the student is sent to retake the test.

14. The results of the interim certification of students will be documented in the electronic transcripts of the BRS system and can be viewed in the student's portfolio.

The instruction was considered and unanimously approved at a meeting of the Department of Medical Biology with a course of microbiology and virology (Protocol No12 05/12/2025.).
